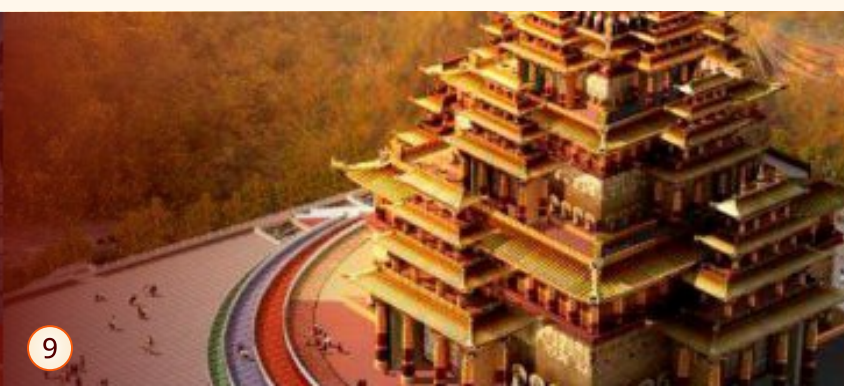

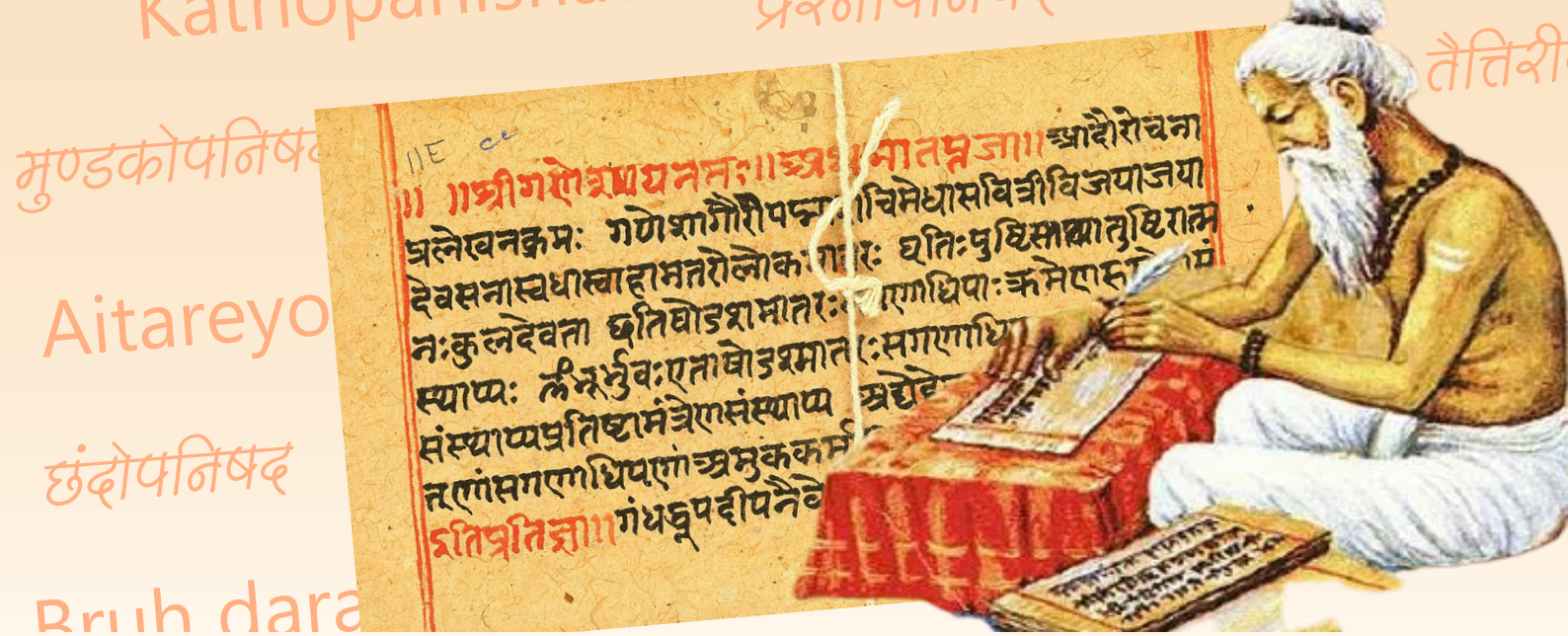

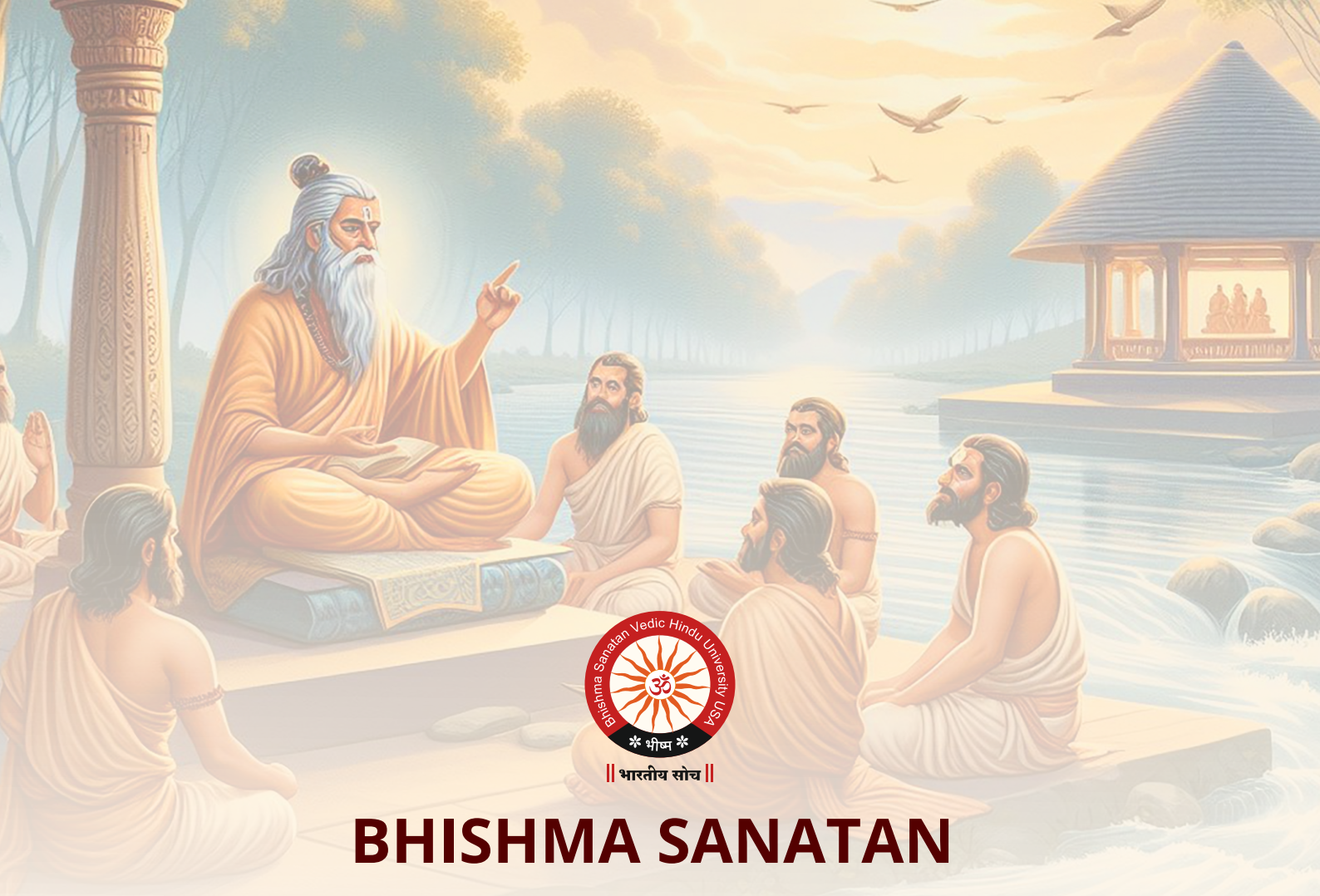




Rules and Regulations
